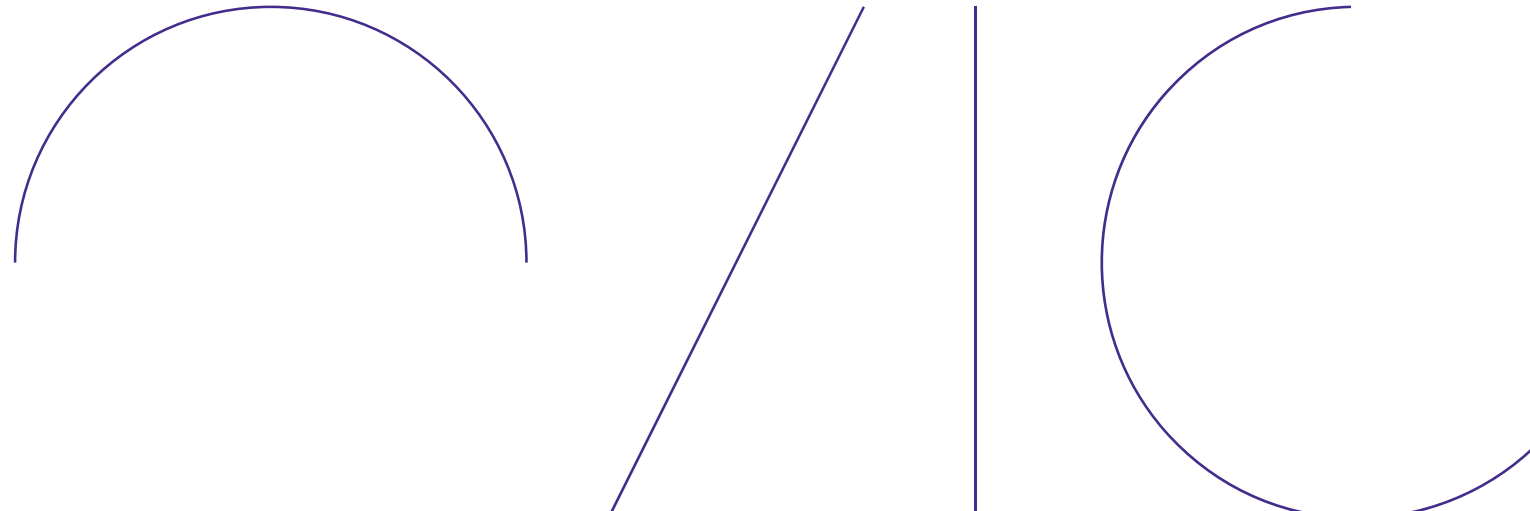

Record Management recommendations

- Providing recurring RM and FOI education for wider agency employees, including executives.
- Ensuring that RM rollout is consistent with both with RM best practice and FOI efficiency.
